6th Grade Honor Roll Projects

Must complete at least ten of these projects. Each must be checked and initialed by your teacher.

1. Prepare 2 written book reports from the list of classics provided by your teacher. Forms may be picked up in your classroom.
2. Successfully participate in the 6th grade Student Council
3. 95% attendance at school for the year (95% = 7 days)
4. Perform a service project under the direction of a teacher or parent. The project must be approved before you begin and a report form filled out upon completion. (Collection projects will be limited)
5. 100 math facts under 3 minutes. A test will be given on each:
 - a. addition
 - b. subtraction
 - c. multiplication
 - d. divisionEach test will have 100 problems. You may take them as many times as necessary. You must pass all four tests with 100% accuracy in 3 minutes or less.
6. Be a participant in the PTA Reflections Contest for the school.
7. Using the same writing process we do in class, publish a book, booklet, poem or story that was written at home. Published works must be shared with the class or a group.
8. Correctly label at least 100 countries in the world on a map.
9. Choose a Renaissance artist that you are particularly interested in and write a one page (typed) biography about them. You must fill out a form and attach it to your project.
10. Keep a current event journal for a full week (7 days) Report on different current events each day and fill out a form for each current event. Forms can be picked up in your classroom.
11. Write a one page (typed) persuasive essay supporting your view on the following topic:
Would it have been better to live during the ancient times or to live today?
12. Plan and execute an experiment about microbes at home and prepare a presentation on what you did. This project may be done with a partner, although each partner must do a presentation. Forms can be picked up in your classroom.
13. Receive a 90% or higher on every monthly project for the year.
14. Have zero missing assignments for at least two of the four terms.
15. One other project or activity of your choice that is first approved by your teacher or parent. Form may be picked up in your classroom.
