You will be assigned a Greek God or Goddess and create a visual model (like a trident if you have Poseidon). You will also write a report through Google Drive written in 1st person, so it is your god or goddess speaking.

**\*\*PARENTS\*\*** Please be aware that with ancient art (sculptures/paintings etc.), there are often nude portrayals of people. I have discussed the possibility of seeing these things with the students, but I wanted to also inform you the parents. My advice is to work on this project with your student so you can help monitor what your child is being exposed to. I also ask that any pictures that may be used for the visual aid be a censored and/or appropriate one for the viewing of 6th grade students. Thank you for your understanding.
